

## What is Miniature Art?

Miniature art is fine art. It is a specialty art that is most often extremely detailed, exquisite in color with strength of composition that can more than compete with larger paintings.

This unique art form traces its roots back to the book paintings and illuminated manuscripts of the 7th century. Later, miniature portraits of loved ones were popular, particularly among royalty.

## Exhibit Rules

**ELIGIBILITY:** This exhibit is open to all artists, 18 and over.

**MEDIA:** Any two or three dimensional fine art media, including non-digital photography, hand pulled prints, pottery, fiber and sculpture. (No crafts or reproductions will be accepted.)

**SIZE:** 2-dimensional work must be no larger than 35 square inches (not including the frame). 3-dimensional artwork must be no larger than 8x8x8 inches, including the base, and must be securely attached to the base or must stand freely if no base is required.

2-dimensional work must be framed or have wrapped, finished edges, be dry and ready to hang.

3-dimensional work must be original and not made from kits or pre-cast forms.

**IDENTIFICATION:** Title, medium, artist and price must properly identify all work. Art should be available for sale.

**NUMBER OF ENTRIES:** Artists may submit one or two entries.

**ENTRY FEES:** There is no entry fee for this exhibit.

**DELIVERY ARTWORK:** Entries should be shipped directly to the Carriage Factory Gallery. Artwork should arrive at or be delivered to the Carriage Factory Gallery no later than November 15, 2009.

**ACCEPTING ARTWORK:** Artwork is accepted and installed at the discretion of the Director and the Board of Directors of the Carriage Factory Gallery.

We have a large exhibit area and as much of the submitted artwork as possible will be exhibited. In the event we receive too many pieces for all to be exhibited, one piece from every submitting artist will be displayed. If that piece sells, the second piece will be displayed.

No work featuring nudity will be accepted.

*All artwork* will be displayed on the gallery's web site throughout the duration of the physical exhibit.

**SALES:** A 40% commission will be charged on all sales. Artists will be notified in the event of a sale and will receive checks approximately three weeks after the close of the show.

**INSURANCE:** The Carriage Factory Gallery carries insurance on all exhibits while artwork is in the gallery's possession. Gallery insurance DOES NOT cover damage or loss duration transit.

**RETURN OF ARTWORK:** Payment for shipping must be included with the artwork.

US Shipping Fee: \$15

International Shipping Fee: \$30

If you have an account with a carrier such as UPS, FedEx, DHL or others, you are encouraged to provide return shipping labels, including your shipping account number.
